with interest thereon from date at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid. annually

until paid in full the last day of each month when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

C. Leag, his heirs and assigns forever,

all that certain piece parcel or lot of land, situate, lying, and being in the state and county aforesaid, on Mountain Creek road at the intersection of Reservoir Road, about six miles above the city of Greenville, and being a part of the land inherited by J. A. Green from his father's Estate, and having the following lines and corners, to wit,
