an old road at the rear of S. R. Roe's dwelling and running
thence S. $7\frac{1}{4}$ W. 18.50 chs. to an iron pin in the Cannon
Road, near a persimmon (dead); thence N. $86\frac{3}{4}$ W. 8.00 chs.
to a spot on West bank of branch; thence down said branch
S. 25 W. 2.90 chs; thence S. 26 W. 2.85 chs. thence S. $21\frac{1}{2}$ W. 3.30
chs. near a spring on opposite side of branch; thence S.
