All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview Township, County and State aforesaid, being known and designated as Tract #3 upon a plat of the property of George C. St. L. between made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, March 1920, and having the following vertices and boundaries to wit: Beginning at a pin in the fork of an old road at the Southeast corner of Tract #3, and running thence S. 17 E. 5.75 chains to point in center of bridge; thence 34-16 N. 5.27 to black gun; thence 34-18 S. 110 chains to stone on branch; thence with the meanderings of said branch in a northeasterly direction 4.26 to a stake; thence S. 48-45 W. 17.63 to point at creek; thence with the meanderings of said creek in a southeasterly direction 34-16 chains to a point in center of bridge; at road thence following said road in a northeasterly direction to the beginning corner, and containing twenty-three + 17/100 (23.17) acres, shall be less, and being the same day Conveyed unto me by the said J.
