in the full and just sum of Eleven Hundred and fifty-five 69.00 (\$1155.60)  
Dollars, to be paid Jan. 1st. 1922,

with interest thereon from interest at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid monthly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue  
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

bargain, sell and release unto the said J. B. Nasson

All that tract parcel or piece of real estate lying and being situated in Oaklawn Township, State and County aforesaid containing sixty 9/10 acres more or less on waters of Little Creek being the tract conveyed to me by W. P. Rodgers and recorded in Vol. 44 page 326 date 31st Dec. 1918 in office A. M. C. for Greenville Co. and having the following meter and bounds to-wit:
