until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue  
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

One thousand dollars paid besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collected as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said B. C. Adams,  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said  
Hattie C. Carpenter and Mary Ella Carpenter  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said Hattie C. Carpenter and Mary Ella Carpenter

their heirs and assigns forever,

All those two pieces, parcels or lots of land, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, in a subdivision known as "Monaghan Hill", and being known and designated as Lots nos. 103 and 104, according to a plat of said subdivision recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "A" at page 70, and being separately described as follows:

Lot no. 103: Beginning on Parker Avenue, 56 feet from Monaghan Mill property, and running thence back along line of Lot #104, 192, 24 feet; thence S. 12.30 E. 62 feet to Lot #102, thence along line of lot #102, 198. 3 feet to Parker Avenue; thence along said Avenue 56 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot conveyed to me by A. A. Pearson by deed dated May 19, 1916, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, in Vol. 39, page 356.

Lot no. 104: Beginning on Monaghan Mill property at Parker Ave, and running back 200 feet; thence S. 12.30 E. 62 feet to Lot no. 103, thence back toward Parker Avenue along line of lot no. 103, 199.2 feet to said Avenue; thence along Parker Avenue 56 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot conveyed to me by Mrs. W. L. and W. L. Burden by their deed dated November 24, 1908, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 11 page 363.
