at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,

bargain, sell and release unto the said Paul R. Barton, his heirs and assigns,

all that certain piece parcel or tract of land situate, lying  
 and being in Austin township, State and County aforesaid  
 and lying on the east side of the Greenville and Laurens  
 Road [now also as the Capitol Highway] and about  
 three quarters of a mile north of the town of Simpson-  
 ville, having the following metes and bounds, to wit:  
 Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of the Green-  
 ville & Laurens Road and running thence N. 54-15 E. 280  
 feet to iron pin in center of George League Road; thence  
 along said road N. 8-10 W. 176 feet to iron pin; thence N.  
 69-18 E. 288 feet to oak; thence S. 20-50 E. 86 feet to iron pin;  
 thence N. 54-15 E. 1605 feet to stone; thence N. 60 W. 945 feet to stone; thence S. 28-45 W.  
 330 feet to stone; thence N. 60-45 W. 1155 feet to stone; thence S. 2-45 E. 214 <sup>1/2</sup> feet  
 to stone; thence S. 10-45 E. 445 <sup>1/2</sup> feet to iron pin; thence S. 51-30 W.  
 681 feet to iron pin on north side of Laurens Road; thence along said road to the be-  
 ginning corner, as follows: S. 38 E. 146 feet to iron pin; thence S. 34-45 E. 160 feet to iron  
 pin; thence S. 30-35 E. 840 feet to the beginning corner, containing 52 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> acres. more or  
 less, and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by O. H. and May P. Garrett on  
 Dec. 31, 1919 and deed recorded in Vol. 55 at page 131 in the office of the R.M.C. for  
 Greenville County.

(2) There is excepted, however, from this mortgage the two tracts of land which I  
 deeded to J. O. Gresham on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of Oct. 1920, one tract containing 11.54 acres,  
 and the other containing 6.28 acres, said deed being recorded in the of-  
 fice for Greenville Co. in Vol. 69 at page 112.

Also there is excepted an additional acre which I deeded to the said J. O. Gres-  
 ham on the day of Jan. 1921, and which deed is unrecorded. This  
 additional acre adjoins the 11.54 acres on the south and fronts on  
 the said Laurens Road.
