

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

That I Annice I. Wardlaw  
of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:  
WHEREAS, I, the said Annice I. Wardlaw  
in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 1st day of October 1923  
Ram indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate,  
duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Three Hundred Fifty + no/100 (\$350.00) Dollars,  
with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 1st day of October A. D. 1923,  
according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that  
the said Annice I. Wardlaw shall pay or cause to be paid to the said  
Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of October  
1923, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Nine + 33/100 (\$9.33)  
Dollars, 7.00 Dollars,  
being the regular monthly installment payable on the three one-half (3 1/2) Shares of Stock, and Two + 33/100 (\$2.33)  
Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the  
sum of Eight + 86/100 (\$8.86) Dollars, 7.00 Dollars,  
Dollars, being the the regular monthly payment on said stock and One + 86/100 (\$1.86) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);  
for the next ten months the sum of Eight + 40/100 (\$8.40) Dollars,  
7.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and One + 40/100 (\$1.40)  
Dollars, being the monthly intrest on balance due); for the next ten months pay the sum of Seven + 93/100 (\$7.93)  
Dollars, 7.00 Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and  
three cents (.03) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next ten months pay the  
sum of Seven + 47/100 (\$7.47) Dollars, 7.00 Dollars, being the  
monthly payment on said shares of stock and forty seven cents (.47) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)  
Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said 3 1/2  
shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made I, the said  
Annice I. Wardlaw  
and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me the said Annice I. Wardlaw  
in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the  
said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Annice I. Wardlaw  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company,  
according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me  
the said Annice I. Wardlaw  
in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is  
hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and  
Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

On the east side of McDaniel Avenue in Greenville  
Township, said County and State, Beginning at John  
Jenkins corner on McDaniel Avenue; thence northerly  
with said Avenue 100 feet to A. B. Wardlaw's corner  
thence with A. B. Wardlaw's line, Easterly 165 feet  
thence parallel with McDaniel Avenue Southerly 100  
feet to Jenkins's corner; thence with Jenkins's  
line 165 feet to the beginning corner being some lot  
conveyed to me by J. W. Norwood, deed, bearing date  
of January 28th 1920, and recorded in the P. M. C. Office  
for said Greenville County in Book 66 page 437.
