being a subdivision of the Morgan Hill Addition as shown on a plat made by W.A. Hudson, March
8th, 1904, and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a stake on the south side of Summit Street one hundred seventy-one feet and ten
and one-half inches from the corner of Summit and Parker Streets, and running thence with said
Summit Street N. 83-3/4 E. one hundred three feet one and one-half inches to an iron pin;
