at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *H. Wallace & H. Greenway, Jr.*

the tract of land tract 7, located by me, being and situated about five miles west of the City of Greenville, and bounded by the said tract of land, containing three acres, being the remainder of tract 7, section 1, acre 6, (32.6) square feet, succeeded by sale of Henry Steff, Henry Ware, Wm. John Dimon, R. C. Clegg, and Richard H. Clegg, the same lands conveyed to H. Wallace & H. Greenway, Jr. by Robert Clegg, by deed dated 10 May 1903, filed in record office of R. C. Clegg, Deed Book C, page 429.
