WHEREAS, *I, W. M. Guest*, the said..... in and by *me* certain promissory note..... in writing, of even date with these presents, *as* well and truly indebted to *W. P. Gauntrell*

in the full and just sum of *One Thousand Five Hundred (\$1,500.00)* Dollars, to be paid *Seven hundred and Fifty Dollars per year* from date and *Seven hundred and fifty Dollars* two years from date.

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *7* per cent. per annum to be computed and paid *quarterly*.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *10%*.

.....besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note..... to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note..... reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said..... *W. P. Gauntrell*,

all that certain parcel and tract of land situate and being in the County and State aforesaid in Highland Township on the North side of Highland and Bigerville Road and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stake in the center of said road (Bartons Corner) and running thence N. 2 W. 17° 00' chs to a stake in the old road thence N. 17° 30' E. 9.16 chs to stake in the old road, thence N. 30° 40' W. 11.75 chs to a chestnut (down) thence S. 30° 40' W. 33.68 chs to a stake thence S. 2 W. 12.00 chs to a stake in the center of the Highland Bigerville Road thence N. 51° 30' E. 3.50 chs to a yard in said road thence N. 64° E. 9.50 chs to a yard in said road thence N. 80° 30' E. 13 chs to a yard in said road thence N. 73° E. 2.60 chs to a yard in said road thence N. 68° E. 3.15 chs to the beginning corner and bounded by land of Barton, Emma Mitchell and others and being portion of the R.
