To all whom These Presents may Concern:

I, B. M. Kilgore, of the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, send greeting. Whereas, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted to the Life Insurance Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Virginia, with its principal office in the City of Richmond, Virginia, doing business in the State of South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, in the full sum of Thirty-five Thousand Dollars (\$3500.00), for making payment, as aforesaid by my son certain promissory notes signed by B. M. Kilgore, of Seven dates herewith, payable either at or on the date of maturity at its Principal Office, Richmond, Virginia, interest part of the date of 8 years and to become due and payable at Greenville, in the sum of \$175.00 Nov. 1, 1925, \$175.00 Nov. 1, 1927, \$175.00 Nov. 1, 1928; \$175.00 Nov. 1, 1929; \$175.00 Nov. 1, 1930; \$175.00 Nov. 1, 1931; \$175.00 Nov. 1, 1932; \$175.00 Nov. 1, 1933; and \$175.00 Nov. 1, 1934. and numbered respectively "Principal Note No. 10" to Interest Note No. 10."

And Whereas, the Mortgagor and Mortgagee do hereby agree that the above aforesaid principal notes shall bear interest before maturity at the yearly rate of Seven per centum per annum, and shall be evidenced by aforesaid notes in the amounts and to become due and payable as follows: \$122.50, 5-1-25, 11-1-25; \$116.38 5-1-26, 11-1-26; \$116.38 5-1-27, 11-1-27; \$104.12, 5-1-28 5-1-28; \$98.00 5-1-29, 11-1-29; \$91.88, 5-1-30, 11-1-30; \$85.75 5-1-31, 11-1-31; \$75.50 5-1-32, 11-1-32; \$73.50, 5-1-33, 11-1-33; and \$67.50 5-1-34, 11-1-34; and numbered respectively "Interest Note No. 10" to Interest Note No. 20."

The first interest note will bear interest partly on earned interest. Each of the principal and interest notes provide for the payment of ten per cent. of the amount due thereon when collected, as an attorney's fee if collection, if, after notice and default in the payment, it be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection. Said contract contains a waiver of presentation, demand, protest and notice of dishonor, presentment and extension, as by reference to said protest more fully appear.

Now, Know All Men, that the Mortgagor, for better securing the payment of the money aforesaid, interest thereon, as well as the payment when due by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagee of all other sums becoming due under the terms of said notes and of this mortgage, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery (next page).
