And it is still further specifically understood and agreed that there shall remain open for the further securing of the debt, as aforesaid, a certain obligation which is open, previously given by Alex Cagle unto the Norwood National Bank of Greenville, S.C. as is represented in a mortgage recorded in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Book 79, at page 70. It being specifically understood and agreed that this said mortgage shall remain a valid and subsisting lien against the property there covered.
