

Also released and relinquished from the lien  
of the foregoing judgment all water lines, pipe  
lines, telephone lines, electric light lines, and  
rights of way for the same, whether leading  
to or upon the said property, together with  
all streets running through, over and upon  
the property referred to above. It being the  
purpose of this release to allow the said  
W. D. Workman to sub-divide the property  
aforesaid, cut the same into lots, mortgage  
the lots and sell off the property with full  
water and light privileges, free and clear  
of the lien of our judgment above referred  
to.

It is specifically understood and agreed  
however, that the said judgment is not  
being released against the said W. D.  
Workman, but only the property referred  
to above is released therefrom.
