To all whom these Presents may concern:

I, R. A. Ellison of the County of ~~Greenville~~ in the State aforesaid, send & reciting:

Whereas, I the said R. A. Ellison am indebted in and by my certain Note bearing date the 25th day of June A.D. 1925 in the sum of three thousand and no 00 Dollars payable to J. F. Dalton or his assigns, on or before June the 25th, 1926 at the rate of eight per cent per annum, which is not paid when due, to become a part of the principal and to bear the same rate of interest, as the principal debt, and if placed with an Attorney for collection, agreed to pay ten per cent as attorney's fees, and my said Note, reference being thereto had and will hereinafter appear.

Now, know all men, That I the said R. A. Ellison in consideration of the sum of one dollar and note aforesaid, and the performance of the foregoings hereinabove named and contained in the said Note and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to me paid hand paid and truly received by the said J. F. Dalton at and before the sealing ~~satisfaction~~ of day and year of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. F. Dalton the following:

All that certain ~~piece~~ parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the West side of Augusta Road and being known and designated as lots no. 4 and no. 3 and a portion of lots no. 19 and no. 18 on a plat of a survey by R. E. Dalton, C. E. August 1922, said lots of land being described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of Augusta Road at a joint corner of lots 2 and 3 and running parallel two hundred feet with Augusta Road and thence West 40° 5' feet to a stake and thence North 200 feet then East 401.5 feet to Augusta Road.

This being the identical property conveyed to me by John R. Morris and C. P. Simmons on the 6th day of December 1924, and recorded in the Clerk's Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Book no. 158 and pages no. 7 and 8.

It is understood by the holder of this mortgage, that there is another prior mortgage in the sum of sixteen hundred and no 00 Dollars, and also one in favor of C. P. Simmons in the sum of twenty-five hundred and no, 00 Dollars.
