

1. This Agreement, made in duplicate this 19<sup>th</sup> day of December, A. D. 1927, by and between John A. Cureton of the County of Greenville and State of S. C., party of the first part, and The Penn Mutual Life Insurance Company, Philadelphia, Pa., a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Pennsylvania, party of the second part;
2. Witnesseth, that whereas the said party of the second part is holder and owner of a promissory note for \$ 2750.00, now reduced to \$ 1750.00 made by John A. Cureton dated January 4, A. D. 1923 payable to the order of The Penn Mutual Life Insurance Company, and which note secured by a mortgage on real estate in the county of Greenville and State of South Carolina, described as follows, to wit: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on the north side of Buist Ave. and being part of Lot 20 and part of lot 21 of the subdivision of the Buist lands, known as Oakland Heights, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake 692 ft. from the corner of Robinson St. and Buist Ave; thence in a northerly direction 170 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. to a stake on a 19 ft. alley; thence with said 19 ft. alley in a westerly direction 65 ft. to a stake; thence in a southerly direction 170 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. to a stake on Buist Ave; thence with Buist Ave. in an easterly direction 65 ft. to the beginning corner, being composed of parts of two lots conveyed to me by Mrs. M. B. Foster by deeds dated Oct. 14, 1921 and Nov. 16, 1921 and recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. 62 page 348 and Vol. 78 page 67, said mortgage being filed for record in the R. M. C. Office of said County on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of January, A. D. 1923, in Book 126, on page 11.
3. And whereas, the said party of the first part is the present owner of said property.
