until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount of principal and said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness, attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All my undivided one half interest in that certain lot or parcel of land situate lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid on the west side of Laurens Street and having according to Survey made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer August 1923, the following Miles and Bounds to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of Laurens Street which iron pin is the corner of a twelve (12) inch brick wall, corner of E. P. Bates deceased, property and running thence along the center line of said twelve (12) inch brick wall N. 69-00 W. 63-3 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 20-54 W. 44-1 feet to an iron pipe in line of property of the estate of T. S.
