WHEREAS, I, the said G. B. Foster as Trustee

in and by May certain 1926, note in writing, of even date with these presents, to me, well and truly indebted to The South Carolina National Bank, a corporation under the laws of the United States of America, fifteen hundred and no/100 (\$15,000.00) dollars, to be paid as follows: fifty (\$50.00) dollars on the first day of August, 1926, and fifty (\$50.00) dollars on the first day of each and every month thereafter until paid in full, payment to be credited semi-annually.

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually in advance.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases, the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

Foster as Trustee, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The South Carolina National Bank, U. S. at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The South Carolina National Bank,

all the aforesaid certain lot or parcel of land situate lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid on the north side of West Coffey Street, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 8 and 9 of the W. Harton property and having, according to a survey made by C. M. Farnham Jr. Engineer, the following metes and bounds to wit.

Beginning at a point on the north side of West Coffey Street which point is 19 ft. 6 1/2 inches west of Richardson Street, and running thence with said Coffey Street S. 69-10 E. 40 ft. to a point in the center of a wall, thence with the center of said wall N. 21-44 E. 65 ft. to a point on the south side of an 8 foot Alley thence with the southern side of said Alley N. 69-10 W. 40 ft. to a point on said Alley; thence S. 21-44 W. 65 ft. to the point of beginning.
