in and by us certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, in the full and just sum of \$1,000.00, well and truly indebted to Susan C. Mills, trustee, Dec. Greenville, 1911, 6.9 per cent. per annum, to be paid in one year after date, with interest thereon from the day of payment until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose his mortgage, and in case said note, after maturity, should be taken in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity, should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage, in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the amount of his attorney's fees, to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under the mortgage as a part of said debt.
