NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, THAT I the said C.M. Martin for and in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the Jean M. Davis according to the terms of said note......, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Bollars to ....in hand well and truly paid by the said... Jean M. Davis at and before the signing of these Presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jean M. Davis, All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville and County and State aforesaid beginning at an iron pin on the South side of West Washington Street, corner of lot #5 as shown on plat made by J.K.Dickson, Surveyor, and recorded in R.M.C. Office for the said County in Vol. L.L., at page 60; and running thence with Washington Street N. 50 W. fifty feet to an iron pin, corner of lot of Ressie V. Pettus; thence at right angles with Washington Street, two hundred and seventeen and eighttenths feet to an iron pin; thence S. 50 E. fifty feet to an iron pin, corner of lot #5; thence with line of lot #5, two hundred and seventeen and eight-tenths feet to the beginning corner, and containing one-fourth of an acre, more or less, and being the same lot of land conveyed to W.N. Dodd by Jas. L. Martin by deed dated 8th, day of November 1912, and recorded in R.M.C. Office in Vol. #20 at page 472.
