computed and paid *Semi-annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fees besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Henry P. Mc Gee*

All those certain lots in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, near New's Station on P. & N. Railway in sub-division known as Newlands and having such metes and bounds as shown by a plat made by A.S. Bedell and recorded in Plat Book C, at page 199 R.M.C. Records for Greenville County:

Beginning at the northeast side of the intersection of the Furman Road and Newland Avenue and running thence along Newland Avenue N. 55-10 W. about 225 feet to the corner of Lot #48 on said plat; thence N. 42-25 E. about 194 feet along the rear line of Lots Nos. 48, 49, 50 and 51 and a portion of the rear line of #52 to the line of land formerly sold to W.A. Martin; thence S. 38-30 W. about 335 feet to the north edges of the Furman Road; thence in a westerly direction along Furman Road to the beginning corner on which is located a dwelling.

Also, Lots 55, 56 and a portion of lot marked reserved on said plat and five (5) feet frontage of lot #57, the same fronting on Charles Street and running back to W.A. Martin's line. The above lots being the same conveyed to me by A.G. New by deed dated November 8th, 1918 and recorded in Volume 51, page 239, R.M.C. Records for Greenville County.

Also, Those three lots known and designated on said plat as Lots Nos. 48, 49 and 50 of Block A, conveyed to me by G.C. Smith, by deed dated July 14th, 1919 recorded in Volume 43, page 580, R.M.C. Records for Greenville County.

Also, That lot known and designated as Lot #54 in Block A, on said plat more fully described in deed to me by Carl Jenkins, dated September 23, 1918 and recorded in Volume 42, page 523, R.M.C. Records for Greenville County.

Also, Lots #53 and that portion of lot #57 not included in the above description having metes and bounds as shown by said plat, and more fully described in deed from A.G. New to me dated November 8th, 1919 recorded,

Also, Lots Nos. 51 and 52 in Block A, as shown by said plat and more fully described in deed by W.R. Jones to me dated November 8th, 1919 recorded.
