Dollars, to be paid One (1) year after date

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of Seven per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of princi-  
pal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per centum besides all costs and expenses of collection to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collected as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any  
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do  
grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Rosa H. Goodwin

All that certain lot of land, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, being known and designated as lot no. 32, as shown on plat recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book "E", at page 132, more fully described as follows:  
Beginning at a point on Parker Street joint corner of lots no. 32 and 33, running thence with line of lot no. 33, S. 40.15 E. 113 feet to corner of lot of John N. Williams and Martha W. Zimmerman; thence with line of lot of Martha W. Zimmerman, N. 49.50 E. 79 feet to corner of lot no. 31; thence with line of lot no. 31, N. 40.15 W. 114.6 feet to Parker Street, thence with Parker Street, S 48.49 W. 79 feet to the point of beginning.
