at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Sayeth Carolina Springs Bank,

as Receiver for The Peoples Bank of Mountain Inn S.C.  
All that, certain parcel of tract of land containing  
eighty three and fifty four one hundredths  
(83.54) acres, more or less, situated, lying and  
being about one and one half miles west of  
Mountain Inn, in the County of Greenville and  
State of South Carolina, in Palmetto Township  
with the following metes and bounds to wit.

Beginning at a point in center of road leading  
from Mountain Inn to Elzer at a point  
adjoining lands of E. E. Gary and Ernest Ann  
Strong, and running and running thence along  
said road N 60 E. 9.3 ft to center of road; thence S.  
68 E. 2.92 to W. D. Edwards line; thence S. 7 1/4 E. 22 to  
pine stump; thence S. 72 W. 27.70 to white oak  
stump; thence S. 53 1/4 W. 15 to center of branch; thence  
N. 8 1/2 W. 3.65 to center of branch; thence N. 59 1/4 E. 5.67  
to center of branch; thence N. 36 E. 6.21 to center  
of branch; thence N. 32 3/4 W. 3 1/2 to center of branch;  
thence N. 13 E. 5 to center of branch; thence N. 54 3/4  
E. 3 to center of branch; thence N. 19 1/4 W. 3 to an  
iron pin; thence N. 2 1/2 W. 5.80 to the beginning  
corner; this being a portion of the M. E. S. Gary Estate  
and being the same tract of land conveyed  
to me by deed of Ernest Gary, dated October  
26th, 1927 and not yet recorded.
