until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, and note further providing for an attorney's fee of *5* per cent.

and to collect the same besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as is, and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN THAT *I*, the said *J. T. Hamby*, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, do the said *Mortgagor*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. T. Hamby*, his

successors, heirs or assigns, all of that tract of land, situate in the County and State of aforesaid, containing 12 acres, more or less, and situated on the south west side of Parker Road and has a dwelling house thereon; Beginning at an iron pin on said road and running thence S. 10 E. 1655 feet to an iron post; thence S. 20 E. 176 feet to a stake; thence S. 81.45 E. 21 feet to a stake; thence N. 56.10 E. 1444 ft. to a corner of said Parker Road; thence N. 26.3 degrees 6 feet to the beginning same deeded to me by Nellie Grace J. Brown.
