Dawson, its successors and assigns forever, all that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Northeast side of Burcombe Road, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, near the village of the American Spinning Company, and being known and designated as Lot No. 24, on a Plat made by W. A. Hudson, the same being recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. N. N. N, at pages 484 and 485, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at the corner of Lot No. 23 on Wright Avenue and running thence with line of Lot No. 23 N. 59 1/4 E.
