SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Arthur S. Agnew, in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

W R Hale, Trustee, in the full and just sum of Three Thousand and no 00 Dollars, to be paid one year after date,

with interest thereon, from date due in full at the rate of six percent per annum to be computed and paid semi-annually.

unpaid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

one hundred dollars, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN THAT the said Arthur S. Agnew, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

W R Hale, Trustee, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me July 1st, the said

Arthur S. Agnew, in hand well and truly paid by the said W R Hale, Trustee,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W R Hale, Trustee, his successors

and assigns:

all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, on Branch Waters of Richland Creek, of Reedy River and on the East side of Piney Mountain containing 35 acres, more or less, and described as follows:

Beginning at a stone, thence N. 43° 21' 82 to stone, thence S. 39 1/3 W. 3.27 to stone, thence S. 45 1/4 W. 11.50 to stone, thence S. 36 E. 22.03 to stone, thence 45 1/4 E. 17.65 to the beginning corner. Said tract being bounded by lands of Ross H. Marchbanks, lands of T. F. Saint Jones Estate and others.

Also those eighteen certain lots being described and designated as follows L 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 67, 68, 69, 70, 71, 72, 73, 74, 75, 76, 77, 78, and 79. Said lots being situated on Lake Drive and Piney Road, near Piney Mountain.
