SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, *J. F. B. Massingale*, the said *J. F. B. Massingale*, in and by my certain promise, made this *1st day of April, 1928*, even date with these presents, am now *one year old*, well and truly indebted to

R. G. Tilman in the full and just sum of *Sixty five hundred dollars (\$650.00)* Dollars, to be paid *one year after date*

with interest thereon, from *the day of date* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum to be computed and paid *monthly*

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Legal plus cost*

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *J. F. B. Massingale*

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *R. G. Tilman*

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *J. F. B. Massingale*, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said *R. G. Tilman*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *R. G. Tilman* his heirs and

assignees, *all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, just outside the incorporated limits of the City of Greenville, near Rockford Road, on the south side of Florence Avenue, sub division of Carle Property known as Oaklawn and designated as Lots Nos. 26 and 27 on said Plat, the two lots having a frontage of fifty (50) feet on Florence Avenue and running back in parallel lines 125 feet.*

Being the same property conveyed to *H. P. McFee* by *Mary B. Hallack* by deed dated January 9th, 1922, and recorded in Volume 74, page 288, in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and conveyed to *Wilton R. Chiles* by *H. P. McFee* by deed dated May 6th, 1922, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 74, page 349, and conveyed to *R. L. Ford* by *Wilton R. Chiles* by deed dated September 22, 1925, and recorded in Book 156, page 308, and conveyed to me, the said *J. F. B. Massingale*, by *R. L. Ford* by deed dated March 3rd, 1928, to be recorded.
