WHEREAS, *I*, the said *H. D. Dull*

in and by *my* certain *promissory* note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to *Frank*

*H. Carle, as Administrator of the Estate of Queen V. Farrell,*  
deceased in the full and just sum of *Five Hundred (\$500.00)*

Dollars, to be paid *One year after date*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *eight* per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid *annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten per cent of*  
*amount* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part  
thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bar-  
gain, sell and release unto the said *Frank H. Carle, Administrator*

of the Estate of Queen V. Farrell, deceased,  
his successors and assigns forever,  
All that tract of land in *Dalton* Township,  
Greenville County, South Carolina, bounded  
by lands of *John Dugan, Mrs. Bailey, W. F.*  
*Williams, Hosea Sketon,* Beginning on stone  
S. W. corner; thence N. 86 1/10 E. 14.46 to #3-000; thence  
N. 19 1/8 W. 23.00 to branch; thence up the meander-  
ings of said branch 13.35 to corner of south  
side of branch; thence S. 14 1/2 E. 16.83 to the
