WHEREAS, I, the said E. J. Brown, in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, am well & truly indebted to Peoples National Bank, of Greenville, S. C., in the full and just sum of Three hundred Fifty and no/100 (\$350.00) Dollars, to be paid, November 1st of the 1928, plus costs before and after interest, with interest thereon, from and until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of \$50.00 per cent, per annum to be computed and paid, at the rate of per cent, per annum to be

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of \$50.00 per cent, per annum to be

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Peoples National Bank, of Greenville, S. C.

all those certain tracts of land aforesaid, lying and being in Austin Township, County and State aforesaid, about two miles S. E. of Greenville City and on branch waters of Silders Creek, described as follows: Tract #1 containing forty-seven and four tenths (47.4) acres, more or less, having the same metes and bounds shown in deed from J. W. Brown and Roxey, A. M. Brown to me dated April 12, 1912, recorded in office of A. M. C. for Greenville County in Vol. 19, page 193.

Tract #2 containing five and five hundredths (5.05) acres more or less, ad joining the tracts of land above described, and having the same metes and bounds as set forth in deed from J. W. Brown to me dated December 14, 1921, recorded in Vol. 87 page 137.

Tract #3 containing three and eight-tenths (3.8) acres, more or less, ad joining the above described tract, having the same metes and bounds as set forth in deed from J. L. Faughn to me dated April 12, 1912, recorded in Vol. 19, page 192.
