SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *George F. Andrews* in and by *my* certain *promissory note* in writing, of even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to.

Rosa B. Waddell
in the full and just sum of *Three Thousand (\$300.00)* Dollars, to be paid *three years after date*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *7* per cent. per annum to be computed and paid.

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten dollars each*.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *I*, the said *Rosa B. Waddell* in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Rosa B. Waddell*

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said *Rosa B. Waddell*

in hand well and truly paid by the said *Rosa B. Waddell*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Rosa B. Waddell*

All that certain piece, parcels and lot of land situate in the State and County aforesaid, known and designated as lot No. 49 and part of part of property of Overbrook Land Company, made by B. O. Jones, Esq., September 17th, 1923, being described according to said plat as follows:

Beginning at a point on the south side of Nock Street, joint corners to lots Nos. 48 and 49 and running thence with line of lot No. 48, S. 15-20° 31' 9 feet to point of Balsam Road, thence with said Road N. 85° 41' E. 75 feet to point on said road, joint corners of lots Nos. 49 and 50; thence along line of lot No. 50, N. 9-28 W. 330 feet to point on Nock Street; thence with Nock Street, S. 76-17 W. 80 feet to the beginning corner.
