All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being in Chick Springs Township, in the County and State aforesaid, on the National Highway, and being known and designated in the subdivision of the property of E.M. Wharton as shown on a plat of record in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "B", at page 50, according to a survey made by T.E. Dalton in 1917, as Lot No. 34, aforesaid reference is hereby made to said plat. The metes and bounds of said lot being as follows:

Beginning at a stake, corner lots 32 and 34; thence N. 79-35 E. 60 feet to corner lots 34 and 36; thence N. 11-02 W. 286 feet to a stake, corner on the P&N. Railway right of way thence West along the said right-of-way, 51 feet and 3 inches to a stake, corner lots 32 and 34; thence S. 8-15 E. 265 feet and 2 inches to the beginning corner. This being the same lot of land conveyed to Mrs V.V. McCarter from Ella Perry Moore by deed recorded in Vol. 109, page 582, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.

Office for Greenville County, which reference is hereby granted and made a part hereof having a cottage on National Highway #24 feet by a depth of 286 feet, and bounded by the National highway on the South east and the Piedmont & Northern Railway right of way on the North west.
