Whereas, I, the said Maurice H. Alice,

these presents, am well and truly indebted to Lorraine C. Putman,

in the full and just sum of \$25.00 Dollars  
to be paid 1700 (Year) after date

with interest thereon from date

at the rate of 10% per cent per annum, to be computed and paid until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10%,

besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage), as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Lorraine C. Putman her heirs and assigns, all the certain tract of land, to receive County, State of South Carolina, Land Township, Situate and lying out being year 1864 1/2 acre Major Co, adjoining land of J. W. Turner, Peter Shaeley and others, all having the following lines and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stone 340 M, Shaeley's corner, and running thence N. 82° E. 11.08 to a stone 340 M; thence W. 46 E. 7.00 to a stone 340 M; thence N. 27 W. 17.78 to a stone 340 M; thence S. 23° E. 15.10 to a stone 340 M in road; thence with said road 2.00 tho. to the beginning corner, less however, a tract containing 10 acres herebefore conveyed by J. W. Turner to J. W. Shaeley by, and recorded in Vol. 25 at page 191, the tract above described originally contained 16 acres but after conveying the 10 acres to J. W. Shaeley there remains a balance of 6 acres and being the same property conveyed to me this date by Lorraine C. Putman and deed not recorded, this being a purchase Money Mortgage.
