 until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past  
 due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose  
 this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten percent*  
 besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof if the same be placed in the  
 hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured  
 under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.

That certain tract of land in One  
 Township, said County and state, known as Tract no 8  
 of the R. J. Andea Estate, as surveyed and platted  
 by H. A. Hester, and dated on yeat as of July 9, 1926  
 having metes and bounds, as follow:

Beginning at a corner with J. A. Fowler at the center  
 of the Buncomebe Road, and running S. 36 $\frac{1}{4}$  W. 34.00 to  
 an iron pin on the corner with Tract no 7, on the  
 J. A. Fowler line, thence S. 51 E. 7.40 to an iron pin  
 on the corner of Tract no 7, thence N. 41 E. 35.50 to the  
 center of the Buncomebe road, thence N. 61 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 10-32
