SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I the said *C. G. Thomason*in and by my certain *premises* note in writing, of even date withthese presents, *due* well and truly indebted to *J. B. Warson*in the full and just sum of *One Thousand One Hundred Dollars*to be paid *One year after date*with interest thereon from *date*

at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *\$10.00* besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto made, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That, the said *C. G. Thomason*in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *J. B. Warson*according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me the said *C. G. Thomason*in hand well and truly paid by the said *J. B. Warson*

is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

J. B. Warson, his heirs and assigns, all my right, title and interest in and to all that piece of land lying, situate and being in Greenville Township, State and County of said, and having the following lines and bounds;

Beginning at a point in Fort Shoals Road and running thence N. 29 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 5.60 chains to an iron pin; thence N. 80 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 10.00 chains to a stone on old Ford line; thence South 61 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 4.78 chains to a stone; thence South 58 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 8.70 to a stone; thence South 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 8.36 to a stone; thence East 6.10 chains to a stone; thence South 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 3.83 chains to a stone; thence South 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 7.26 chains to a W. C. C. thence N. 57 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 8.15 chains to a Mulberry; thence South 119 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 3.15 chains to a stone; thence South 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 1.61 chains to a stone; thence South 29 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 10.06 chains to a stone; thence N. 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 17.45 chains to a double black post; thence N. 32 W. 10.74 chains to a stone; thence North 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 2.30 chains to point of beginning in said Fort Shoals Road; and containing of 40.82 acres, more or less, and being all of the same tract of *E. G. Thomason*, et cyp 55/100 acre.

The additional collateral to the within described tract, I hereby assign to *J. B. Warson*, Mortgagee, Six Hundred (\$600.00) dollars of the balance due on note given by *W. J. Thomason* to me, the said *C. G. Thomason* January 26, 1931, originally in the amount of Eight Hundred (\$800.00) dollars, and also secured by Mortgage over a 56 acre tract of land, said Mortgage being recorded in R. M. C. office, Greenville County, Volume 228, at Page 249. It is understood that there is due on the *W. J. Thomason* Note as of December 1, 1932, Seven Hundred (\$700.00) dollars principal, together with Fifty six (\$56.00) dollars interest and it is agreed that the said *C. G. Thomason*, will collect the installment of One Hundred (\$100.00) dollars due December 1, 1932, together with Fifty six (\$56.00) dollars interest due at that time.
