of anticipating payment of the whole at any time
with interest thereon from

at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid annually

the following described property, to wit: all that tract of land situate,
lying and being in the County and State aforesaid. Beginning at a Black
Gum on the Ridge Road 3x0, thence N. 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 26.80 to a corner; thence N. 34 $\frac{1}{2}$
W. 10.20 to a corner on road leading to Greenville; thence N. 30 20.10.76 to a
Spring on Branch; thence up said branch to a stone 3x0 on said Ridge Road;
thence with said road to the beginning corner, adjoining land of J. Manning
Mahaffey, D. S. Smith and tracts no. 4 and 6, and containing seventy-five (75)
acres, more or less. This being the same property conveyed to me by D. S.
Smith by deed dated this the 21st day of Feb. 1933, the same not yet
recorded. Less however, forty-five acres, conveyed to James D. Smith by D. S.
