Mutual Auto Co., their heirs or assigns, all certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate in the State of S.C. Greenville County, beginning at a black oak near a small branch, Mary Loggin's corner, and running thence 61 N. 14 poles to a white oak stump, thence 71. 81 N. 27 poles to a maple, thence N. 4 W. with William Ward's line 58 poles to a rock, thence N. 53 W. 33 poles to a chestnut oak, thence N. 30 E. 8 poles to a white oak, thence N. 51 1/2 E. 50 poles to a dead chestnut sapling, thence with his line S. 62 1/2 E. 87 poles to a white oak on east bank of Fall Creek, thence with his line S. 56 N. 70 poles to a dead oak, thence N. 31 W. 2 poles to a small maple near the road, thence N. 31 W. 2 poles to said road, and with said road 32 poles to Mary Loggin's spring, thence up the branch 23 poles to the beginning corner, containing 80 acres more or less. Being the land I conveyed to J.W. Morgan by W.P. Davis by his deed dated 11th day of Jan. 1915 and recorded in R.M.C. Office of Greenville Co. in Vol. 10 Page 513.
