is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

W. H. Nelson, his heirs and assigns forever.
All that certain parcel of lot of land lying and being situate on Brockman Avenue, in or near Burns Souci, and being in the State of South Carolina, County and Township of Greenville, about two and one-half miles N.W. from Greenville County Court House and having the following metes and bounds, according to a Survey made by C.M. Fidman, Engineer, April 1923, to wit:
Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of Brockman Ave-
ue, 93 feet, 2 inches from the South section of Brockman Ave-
ue and Burnside Road, joining corner of Lots nos. 32 and 33.
and running thence S. 65° 16' 8" feet to an iron pin in rear
of line of lots nos. 32 & 38; thence with the joint line 33 and
38; thence with the joint line of lots 33 & 38, N. 11° 20' 41" feet to
an iron pin; thence N. 59° 17' 5" feet, more or less, to an iron
pin on Brockman Avenue; thence along said Avenue, S. 10° 30' 47.62
feet, more or less, to the beginning corner, and being known
as a portion of lot no. 33 as shown on plat of subdivision
known as Burns Souci Villa, which Plat is of record in Plat
Book "A" at page 510.
