Whereas, *I. Helene M. Smith*

these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to *S. O. Skelton*

in the full and just sum of *Six Thousand Dollars \$6,000.00* Dollars
to be paid three years from date, with privilege of repaying
~~any part or all of said principal and any interest due,~~
~~upon giving 30 days notice in writing~~
with interest thereon from ~~date of~~ *July 1, 1929*

at the rate of *6* per cent. per annum to be computed and paid ~~semi annually~~
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past
due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose
this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten per cent of the amount due*,
besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collected as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the
hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured
under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

S. O. Skelton his Heirs and assigns forever
all that certain piece of land
lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid,
as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at said corner and running
thence along Earle Street in an easterly direction
51 1/2 feet to corner of lot of land
lying in line of Meyers lot 150 feet to back fence;
thence west line of said fence parallel with
Earle Street 51 1/2 feet to Townes Street; thence
with Townes Street in a southerly direction
130 feet to the beginning corner. Being the
easterly lot conveyed to me by Elsie H. Farnsworth
by deed dated March 1, 1927 and recorded in the
R. M. C. Register for Greenville County in Volume 108
page 513.

At the northeast corner of Earle and Townes Streets in the City of Greenville
