at the rate of *7* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *as simple interest*
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past
due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose
this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten (10) percent*
besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the
hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured
under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

All that certain tract of land in the ~~County~~ of Greenville, state
of South Carolina, near Pelham Mills, and known and designated as
Tract #2 of the Mary Susan Smith (or Lucie Poling Smith) lands, accord-
ing to a subdivision and plat thereof made by G. A. Ellis and being re-
corded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 31 at page
234, and having the following lines, and bounds, and courses and
distances as shown by said plat, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of public road,
at the extreme eastern corner of Tract #1, and running
thence along the center of said road and along line of Tract
#1 the following courses and distances: S. 78 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 6.45 to
iron pin, thence S. 60 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 3.00 to an iron pin, thence S.
34 W. 19.16 to an iron pin, thence S. 58 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 9.00 to an iron
pin, thence S. 14 $\frac{3}{4}$ W. 4.00 to an iron pin at corner
of Tract #3, thence along the line of Tract #3 S. 66 E.
12 $\frac{1}{2}$ to an iron pin, thence N. 16 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 36.12 to an iron
pin, at corner of two-acre tract, thence S. 48 W. 4.25
to a stake, thence N. 35 $\frac{2}{3}$ W. 4.38 to a stake, thence
N. 58 E. 5.58 to an iron pin, thence N. 16 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 44.5
links to the beginning corner, containing fifty-seven
