"All that piece, parcel and lot of land in Greenville Township,  
Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being about three  
miles north west of the City of Greenville and known as the  
Colonia Company Tract, being lot #220 on the east side of  
Franklin Road, and having the following metes and  
bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the west side  
of Franklin Road, joint corner of a ten foot alley; thence with  
joint line of lot #220 and the ten foot alley, N. 57-32 W. 200  
feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lot #220 and the ten foot
