at the rate of *7* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *one-half of one per cent* besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, will more fully appear.*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

*People's National Bank of Greenville, S.C.**First*: All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid, on the head waters of Richland Creek of Keedy River, bounded by lands now or formerly of L. J. Jennings, Jas. Austin, Phillip Means, et al. This tract contains about 4 acres and is shown on plat by Wm. A. Hudson, A. S. dated Dec. 14, 1904. This is the same tract of land conveyed to John Byrd by Jane J. Brock, et al., by deed dated Dec. 28, 1904, recorded in R. O. N. C. Office for Greenville County, in Deed Book 000 page 112.*Second*: All that certain piece of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, in Butler Township, about 2½ miles from S.C. H., and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning on a pine 37' and running thence N 47° 2.68' to a rock 38' on road; thence N 85° E. 1.63' to a rock on same road; thence S. 81° E. 5.27' to rock 38' on road; thence S. 71° E. 7.61' to the beginning corner containing nine-tenths (9/10) of an acre, more or less.*Third*: All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the same State, County and Township, adjoining the above tract and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a post-oak; thence S. 73° W. 8.30' chains to a stone; 380 m. thence S. 21° W. 5.00' to a peach-tree 380; thence S. 77° E. 5.95' to a stone 380; thence N. 25° E. 9.25' to the beginning corner, containing four and one-fourth (4 1/4) acres, more or less.
