My said and entire undivided interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land containing 100 acres more or less and being situated in the County and State aforesaid and in Greenville Township about 3 miles northeast of the town of Fountain Inn and being the same tract of land conveyed to me, Madge E. Lowman and C. R. Lowman by deed of T. M. Combs bearing date of June 3, 1931 and being recorded in the P. M. L. Office for Greenville County in Book 156 at page 136 to which reference is made for a full description as to lines, corners, distances, etc. Bounded on the west by Public Road, lands formerly belonging to Davis Mayfield and Laramelle lands, on the east by lands of the W.
