 All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville on the south side of Birnie Street, and having the following metes and bounds, according to a plat made by R. C. Balton, Engr., in February, 1922, to wit: Beginning at a stake on the south side of Birnie Street, corner of lot 4. Irvine property, and running thence with Birnie Street S. 39-41 E. 148.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 29-33 W. 31 b. 7 feet to an iron pipe at the corner of lot shown on said plat as Lot no. "A"; thence N. 69-50 W. 150 feet to an iron pipe at rear corner of F. H. Irvine property; thence along line of said F. H. Irvine property no. 30-00 E. 207.2 feet to the beginning corner on Birnie Street, being part of the property formerly of the Estate of W. H. Irvine.
