All that certain tract of land in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing Fifty-five (55) acres, more or less, BOUNDED on the North by lands of T. D. Bennett; on the East by lands of T. C. Bennett, W. W. Whitt and the old Greenville-Pelzer road; onthe South by the old Greenville-Pelzer road and the lands of T. C. Bennett; on the West by P. &. N. Railroad, State Highway leading from Greenville to Pelzer, lands of C. H. Bennett and Vannie Watt, said tract being specifically described by metes and bounds, according to an old plat made by B. F. Wigington, Surveyor, dated March 17, 1932, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "H", at page 269, and a new plat made by B. F. D. Bennett; thence with the line of T. D.
