On the Northwest corner of Bramlett Road and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
Beginning at a point 110 feet from the Northwest intersection of said Bramlett Road and Woodside Avenue; and running thence parallel with Woodside Avenue in a Northerly direction 150 feet; thence parallel with Bramlett Road in a Westerly direction 65 feet; thence 150 feet to Bramlett Road; thence parallel with Bramlett Road 65 feet to the beginning corner.
