Hudson of the country of Greenville, State of South Carolina, hereinafter polited Mortgagor, has become justly indebted to the United States of America acting by and (through the Segretary of Agriculture, pursuant to the protisions of Title I of the Bankhead-Jones Farm Tenant Act, hereinafter, called Mortgages, as evidenced by one certain promissory note, dated the 12th day, of June, 1939, for the principal sum of Seven Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$700.00), with interest at the pare of three per capat (3%) per annum, principal and interest payable and amortized in installments as therein provided, the Arst installment of thirty and 28/100 Dollars (\$30,28) being my and collectible on the 31st day of December 1939, the next succeeding thirty-fight installments cannually thereofted, and the fortieth installment, either thirty-nine years thereafter or forty years from the date of said note, whichever date is the earlier; and

WHEREAL, Mortgager is desirous of securing the prompt payment of said note, and the several installments yof principal and interest at maturity, and anytextendion or remewals thereof, and any agreements supplementary therto, and any addition indeptedness accuring to Mortgagee on account of the future or expenditures hade as hereinafter provided, and the performance of each and every covenant and screenent of Mortgagor herein contained.

NOW, THEREFORE, in Consideration of the said indebtedness and to secure the prompt/thereof as the same madures or becomes due, and of any extension or renewal thereof, or of any agreement supplementary there to, and to secure the performance of each and every covenant and agreement of Mortgagor homein contained, Mortgagor has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grent, bargain, sell and release unto Mortgagee the following described real estate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, to wit:

All that the train piece, parcel or lot of land situate in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville Butler Township, adjoining lands of K. A. Bull, W. W. Smithe Ed Butler, and others, being a part of the tract of land formerly conveyed by Henry Strong to M. Kendrix.

BEGINNING at a stake on Greenville\*Pelham Road, thence N. 61-60 160, 16t to stone; thence N. 42 W. 509 feet to stone; thence N. 24-40 E. 330 feet to stone; blonge N. 25-20 W. 364.5 feet to stone; thence N. 33 E. 1663 feet to stake in mouth of ditch on Big Rocks creek; thence S. 52-20 E. 185.5 feet to point; thence S. 85 E. 100 feet to point; thence S. 85 E. 100 feet to ditch bank; thence N. 41-45 E. 60.3 feet to point in ditch banks thenge S. 15 E. 402 feet to stake; thence S. 42-30 W. 280.5 feet to stone; thence S. 39.15 E. 508.2 feet to stake; thence S. 33.15 E. 615 feet to stake in Greenville-Pelham Road; thence along said Road S. 37-30 W. 914 feet to stake in bend of Road; thence continuing along said road S. 56.15 W. 657 feet to the beginning corner containing 66 acres, and being designated as Tract No. 1 in plat prepared by H.
