J. Riddle, Surveyor, July 22, 1941, and being bounded on the north by lands of A. G. Huff and Carrie Richardson, on the east by J. F. Richardson, on the south by W. D. Richardson and E. J. Meyers, and on the west by E. J. Meyers, as will appear as to courses and distances and metes and bounds on the Riddle plat which is recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book "I", at page 154. The original of the plat is filed with The Federal Land Bank of Columbia and reference is here made to the original plat and to the record thereof for a more definite and positive description as to courses and distances and metes and bounds.
