on Stadium Street, the Northwestern corner of this lot and at corner of Lot #6, and runs thence S 14-40 W along the line of Lots 3, 4, 5 and 5 191.5 feet to a stake; thence S 70-20 E 35 feet to a stake, corner of Lot #2 on said plat; thence N 26-49 E along the line of Lots 1 and 2 181.2 feet to a stake on Stadium Street; thence N 61-56 W 78 feet to the beginning, and being the same lot of land conveyed to us by J. And we do hereby bind ourselves and our

Heirs, Executors, and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said

CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns, from and against

us and our Heirs, Executors, Administrators and assigns, and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same, or any part thereof.

Vе **AND** do hereby agree to insure the house and buildings on said lot in a sum not less than Five Hundred Dollars fire insurance, and not less than Dollars windstorm insurance, in a Company or Companies acceptable to the Mortgagee, and to keep the same insured from loss or damage by fire Five Hundred and/or windstorm, and do hereby assign the policy or policies of insurance to the said Mortgagee, its successors and should at any time fail to insure assigns, to the extent of its interest therein; and in the event we said premises, or pay the premiums therein, then the said Mortgagee, its successors or assigns, may cause the said houses and buildings to be insured in the owner's name(s), and reimburse itself for the premiums and expense of such insurance under this mortgage, with interest thereon.
