All that piece, parcel and lot of land lying and being in Grove Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, containing One Hundred Ninety-five and 25/100 (195.25) acres, more or less, and being bounded on the north by lands of Junius Garrison, on the east by Junius Garrison, on the south by C. O. Perry and on the west by Mr. Black and Junius Garrison, and being the same tract of land conveyed to Paul K. Thackston by Corris H. Bozeman and others by deed dated January 13, 1938, recorded in Deed Book 201, page 402, R. M. C. Office, Greenville County. This property is fully delineated on a plat prepared by J.
