NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by the said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of the said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand well and truly paid by second party, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release, in fee simple, unto second party, its successors and assigns, the following described lands, to wit:

That all piece, parcel and lot of land lying and being in Austin Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, containing Thirty Eight and 50/100 (38.50) acres more or less, and being bounded on the North by the road with a treet sold off to B. J. Thackston lying across the road, bounded on the East by another tract sold off to B. J. Thackston, on the South by lands of D.G.Mayfield and on the West by the estate of Mamie B.White. This property is fully shown and set forth on plat prepared by W. J. Riddle, dated December 10, 1934, and revised January 14, 1937, which is recorded in Plat Book Page 63, R. M.C. Office, Greenville County and reference is herewith made for a more particular description to that plat.

Notwithstanding any provision herein, or in the note secured hereby, to the contrury, first party may make at any time advance payments of principal in any amount. Advance principal payments made within five years from the date hereof may be applied, at the option of second party, in the same manner as those made after five years from the date hereof.
