of Greenville, South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, is indebted to

C. Douglas Wilson & Co.

, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of South Carolina, hereinafter called Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Eighty-two Hundred and no/100

Dollars (\$8200.00), with interest from date at the rate of four per centum (4%) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of C. Douglas Wilson & Co. in Greenville, S. C.

, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing delivered or mailed to the Mortgagor, in monthly installments of Forty-three and 29/100 Dollars (\$43.29), commencing on the first day of April, 1950, and continuing on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of March, 1975.

Now, KNOW ALL MEN, that Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described property situated in the county of Greenville State of South Carolina; Greenville Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 132 according to a plat of the property of J. P. Rosamond, plat made by Dalton & Neves, April, 1931, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, at Page 186, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southern side of Rutledge Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 131 and 132, and running thence along the line of Lot No. 131, S. 35-28 E. 147 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 141; thence along the rear line of Lots Nos. 141 and 140, S. 55-57 W. 110 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot No. 135; thence along the rear line of Lots Nos. 135, 134 and 133, N. 17-27 W. 168.3 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Rutledge Avenue; thence along the southern side of Rutledge Avenue, N. 69-37 E. 60 feet to iron pin at the point of beginning.
